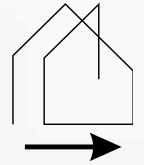

With greater height, broader span options and increased suspended load capacity, the Skyline Orangerie is designed for high-profile venues and large-scale event production.

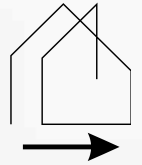

The distinctive double-pitched roof is one of the defining architectural features of the Orangerie. Its elevated central ridge creates additional internal volume and provides a strong sense of space on arrival.

Thermal Roof PVC Covers

Insulated roof solutions can help improve thermal performance, reduce condensation and support more comfortable year-round operation.

Ridge Ventilation

Available with the Skyline Orangerie to support natural ventilation along the elevated central roof section.

Clear Roof Sections

Bring natural light into the venue and create a greater connection with the sky and surrounding environment.

Translucent Roof Panels

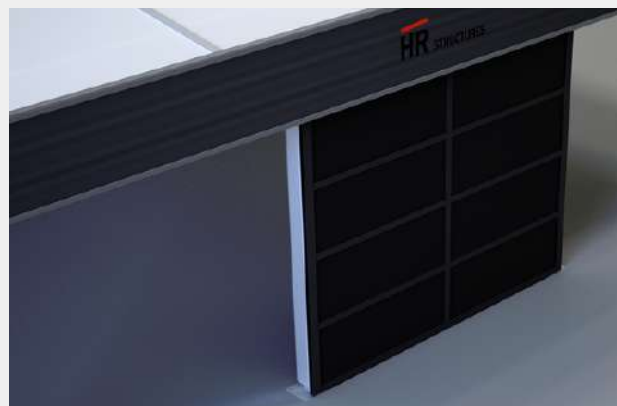
Diffuse daylight throughout the interior while reducing direct glare.

Opaque Roof Systems

Provide shade and a controlled internal environment for event production, exhibitions and hospitality.

Glazed Façades

The Orangerie can be enclosed with expansive glazed wall systems that create open views and allow daylight to move throughout the interior.

Skyline Façade

Used with the Skyline Orangerie, the external façade sits in front of the structural posts to create a seamless, premium architectural finish.

Integrated Façade

The F-Series configuration positions the façade elements between the structural posts, providing a refined and economical solution.

Insulated Wall Panels

Selected areas can be enclosed with insulated panels for back-of-house spaces, service zones or greater environmental control.

PVC Walling

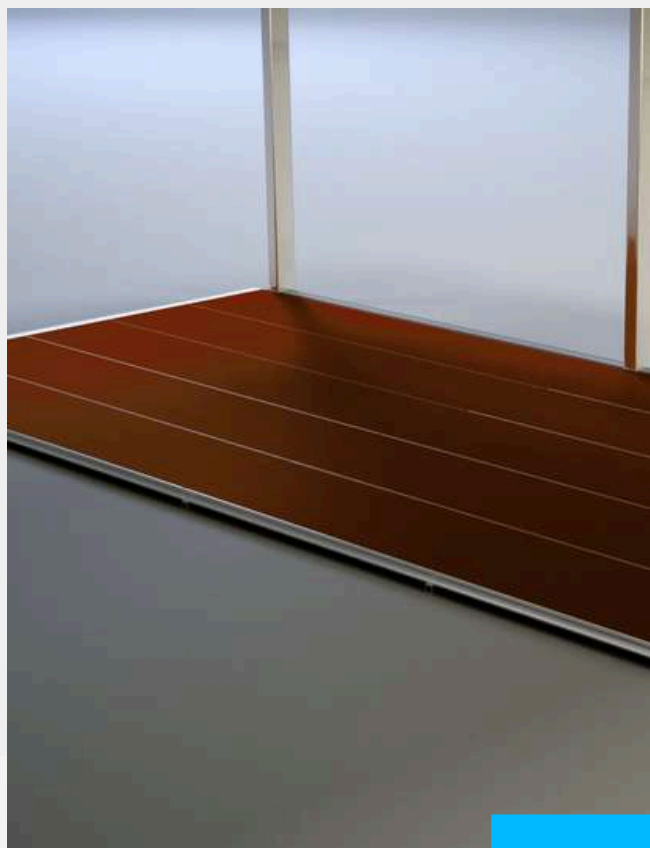
Opaque or translucent PVC walling can be used where glazing is not required.

Custom Frame Finishes

The aluminium structure can be powder-coated in selected RAL colours to complement the event, venue or brand identity.

Cassette Flooring

The premium cassette floor creates a refined, level internal surface suitable for guest-facing environments.

A range of surface finishes can be selected to complement the intended interior, including timber-look flooring, carpet and other decorative finishes.

Heavy Duty Flooring

The heavy-duty system offers a fast and practical floor solution for events, exhibitions and operational environments.

It can be installed efficiently and provides the strength required for furniture, equipment and event production.

Flooring Finishes

Flooring can be completed with:

- Timber-look surfaces
- Carpet
- Vinyl
- Premium event flooring
- Branded finishes
- Temporary surface treatments

Accessibility ramps and transition systems can also be incorporated into the overall design.

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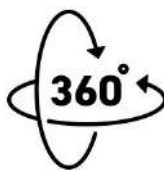
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
